



As you attend SZUSICON 2025, immerse yourself in the vibrant culture, rich history, and scenic beauty of Vijayawada. From ancient temples to serene parks, the city offers a diverse array of attractions to enrich your conference experience.

An iconic bridge spanning the Krishna River, Prakasam Barrage is a marvel of engineering and a symbol of Vijayawada's heritage. By day, it facilitates irrigation and transportation; by night, it transforms into a luminous spectacle, making it perfect for evening strolls and photography. Notably, in 2023, it was recognized as a World Heritage Irrigation Structure by the International Commission on Irrigation and Drainage (ICID), highlighting its historical significance and contribution to irrigation in the region.






PANAKALA LAKSHMI NARASIMHA TEMPLE, MANGALAGIRI

Situated atop the auspicious hill of Mangalagiri, this ancient Vaishnavite temple is one of the eight sacred Mahakshetras of Lord Vishnu in India. Unique to this temple is the ritual where jaggery water (Panakam) is offered to the deity, believed to be consumed by the Lord himself. The temple's spiritual ambiance and panoramic views make it a must-visit.

Standing at 125 feet, the Dhyana Buddha Statue is a testament to peace and meditation. The statue sits on a lotus platform supported by eight pillars, symbolizing Buddha's Eightfold Path to salvation. The surrounding area is divided into zones representing the Four Noble Truths, offering a serene environment for reflection.

UNDAVALLI CAVES


These 4th-century rock-cut caves showcase a blend of Hindu, Jain, and Buddhist architectural influences. Carved out of solid sandstone, the multi-storied caves house a massive monolithic statue of Lord Vishnu in a reclining posture. The site reflects the religious harmony and architectural prowess of ancient India.

Explore Vijayawada Top 8 attractions





Perched atop a hill, Kondapalli Fort dates back to the 14th century and was constructed by the Musunuri Nayaks. Over the centuries, it served various rulers, including the Qutb Shahi dynasty and the British. Adjacent to the fort is the Kondapalli Forest Reserve, home to diverse flora and fauna, making it ideal for nature walks and exploration.



KONDAPALLI FORT & FOREST RESERVE



A haven for bird enthusiasts, this sanctuary near Kolleru Lake attracts migratory birds like spot-billed pelicans and painted storks. Best visited during early mornings, it offers a peaceful environment to observe avian life in their natural habitat.

ATAPAKA BIRD SANCTUARY (KOLLERU LAKE)

Located about 70 km from Vijayawada, this temple is dedicated to Lord Subramanya (Murugan). It's believed to fulfill the wishes of devotees, especially childless couples. The temple's serene setting adds to its spiritual allure.


